### BIG DEMAND FOR WORLD SEAFOOD CONSUMPTION

#### Global seafood consumption (2030):

258 million tons, increase 18%, include: Asia 183 mill tons increase 71%

Aquatic products: 59%

Marine products: 41%.

#### Global Production (2030):

204 million tons, increase 15%

include: Aquaculture 53%, Catching 47%



#### Seafood VIETNAM

- Top 3 largest seafood exporters in the world (after China, Norway), taking 6% of global seafood export value.
- Exporting to nearly 170 markets.
- 692 factories with EU export code, 847 industrialscale factories certified to meet food safety conditions.
- Top 10 major export industries of Vietnam, creating jobs
   & livelihoods for more than 4 million direct workers.
- Export turnover generated by Vietnamese seafood enterprises accounts for 92-95% of Vietnam's total seafood export value.
- Accounts for 10-12% of the total export turnover of domestic manufacturing industries.
- The proportion of Vietnamese private enterprises in seafood export and processing industry accounts for more than 97%.


